1. Lincoln Law School of San Jose ("LINCOLN") is not accredited by the Committee of Bar Examiners of the State Bar of California ("COMMITTEE").

2. LINCOLN was accredited until January 1, 2023, when the accreditation was terminated by the Committee of Bar Examiners for noncompliance with Rule 4.160(D)(6) Minimum, Cumulative Bar Exam Pass Rate. LINCOLN began the application process for reaccreditation on June 7, 2024. On August 16, 2024, the Committee of Bar Examiners approved LINCOLN's application. The corresponding inspection is scheduled for Fall 2024.

3. LINCOLN has been in continuous operation for more than ten years.
